### Dress code

Whilst recognising that pupils may wish to be fashionable, our school expects certain standards of dress and appearance to be adhered to. Uniform must be kept clean and worn tidily at school and on the way to and from school. We offer the following guidelines to Parents/Carers and ask for co-operation in maintaining the high standard of personal appearance we expect from our pupils.

#### Hair, Make Up and Jewellery

Hair styles and haircuts should not involve colouring and should be a minimum of a number 2 clipper cut. No extreme hairstyles, tramlines or patterns are permitted.

For Health and Safety reasons jewellery should not be worn. Make-up and nail varnish is not permitted.

#### Shirts, Ties, Trousers and Skirts

Skirts should be grey or navy and knee length, maxi skirts are not permitted.

Trousers should be grey or navy and should be a tailored smart style. Leggings and jeans are not permitted. We recommend Reception, Year 1 & Year 2 children wear the gold polo shirts for ease of changing when taking part in P.E. activities.

Shirts if worn to be white, tucked into skirts or trousers with the top button fastened. School ties are available from the office.

#### Footwear

All pupils should wear black shoes which are fully enclosed. Canvas shoes, flip flops or Crocs are not suitable. Shoes should not have a heel.

Items of uniform which do not display our logo can be purchased from any shop providing they are the correct colour and style. School tries to keep a stock of items of uniform with the logo on in stock.
